For all Fiction Summaries:

You must write between 3-5 paragraphs which include a short plot summary, main characters (protagonist/antagonist), and key universal themes. The Lexile score and genre should be clearly stated on the summary.

For all Poetry Summaries:

You must include 3-5 paragraphs about the overall themes used in the book of poems. You must also include specific examples of figurative language and explain how it helps teach the theme of the book. The Lexile score and genre should be clearly stated on the summary.

For all Non-Fiction Summaries:

You must include 3-5 paragraphs describing the main events discussed in your book. If it is not about events, it should be a general summary of key information and ideas in your book. You must also include specific examples of things you learned from this book. The Lexile score and genre should be clearly stated on the summary.

For all Book Projects:

One outside book project must be completed each trimester. You cannot do a book project or summary on a book we read as a class. These must be OUTSIDE READING BOOKS ONLY. You may choose from the list of approved projects in class or present an alternative project. You may not do a book project on a book that has a summary. A book project proposal and rubric must be included with your final project. The Lexile score and genre should be clearly stated on the summary.
